GLOSSARY

Your go-to guide to key words, objects, and weapons that help Percy and his pals restore Camp Half-Blood in the new movie Percy Jackson: Sea of Monsters.

- **AEGIS:** The face of Medusa appears on this shield that is used to create fear in others.
- ANDROMEDA: The name of the ship captained by Luke.
- DRACHMAS: Large coins made of gold that are used as Greek currency among demi-gods and to gain entrance into the underworld. They are also used to send messages to Iris. They feature images of gods on one side and the Empire State Building on the other.
- GOLDEN FLEECE: An ancient magical artifact, created from the wool of a golden lamb, that is guarded by Polyphemus the cyclops. The fleece has intense healing powers (even on dying trees) and satyrs, like Grover, are drawn to it.
- HIPPOCAMPUS: The mythical seahorse creature that Poseidon created to serve him. It rises from the water to help Percy in a time of need.

- MATTER ELIMINATOR: Hermes' experimental tape-gun-inspired invention, which creates a black hole and swallows up anything you outline.
- MIST: A supernatural force, guided by Hecate, that disguises monsters and demigods. It also helps make mythological occurrences appear normal to mortals. It even has the power to alter the appearance of a cyclops!
- is powered by the sea, which is why it works so well for him. It helps him battle monsters and immortals, big and small. The sword is made of celestial bronze, a material that doesn't harm mortals or his friends. In Greek, it's known as "Anaklusmos."
- THALIA'S TREE: Marks the border of Camp Half-Blood and is subject to poisoning. The only cure is protection from the Golden Fleece.

• **TRIDENT:** The three-pronged weapon of Poseidon, which gives him the power to control the sea, quake the earth, and destroy any object that gets in his way.
